State law requires immunizations for children entering Kindergarten, 6th and 9th grade. If your child is not current on immunizations additional immunizations may be required.

If your child is caught up on infant & toddler immunizations the following are required and/or recommended when a child enters Kindergarten, 6th and 9th grades:
