current voters; projected high school enrollment 308; EAV 10,847,537, working cash of roughly 13,000,000 maximum; working cash would come in if we wanted to do little jobs to this building, but not advisable to deplete working cash to 0.

Mike and Kim talked about reducing the cost of the building; some suggestions given information reviewed from the 2012 referendum

What does Prime mean in prime farmland from 2011? Would need new information Mike shared a large drawing of the proposed floor plan

Must have a storm shelter now due to code but must accommodate the number of seats the gym holds. The storm shelter must be 5 square foot per person, and it would be under the gym/bleacher seating. Cost estimate with these reductions: Building construction 22,774,916; Site development, except athletic fields 5,366,984; athletic facilities - 2,585,000; and consulting fees - 1, 951,084 for a grand total of 32,626,000.

Currently, the ag shop is not connected - so there were questions about why they were not connected? Mike said that the ag classroom could be connected.

Classroom size is a 950 square foot - more than big enough for 25 students comfortably. This is a good healthy size classroom

Quotes were based on 450 students.

Design, Bid, Build Method - cost estimate

Construction Manager - construction supervisor looking over someone's shoulder

** Potential cost difference between the two

If we build out in the country, it might be to our benefit to go the construction manager route.

How much should IW do the bond issue for? Potentially 16 - 18 issue

Mike shared that LEED is complex and is so much bigger than just the farmland - examples like solar power, windows etc.

Dyken system - based on what most schools have used for HVAC systems.

4 questions:

Bond issue? Wednesday, 17 million, Durham township location, central location - or more centrally located

If Bond issue does it include the site? Yes =name the site

If bond issue spring 20 or fall of 20? spring for a chance at capital money - \$17,000,000 - taxes would go up about 85 cents for the 17,000,000 for the assessed evaluation of the house. Current tax rate is 1.93 goes up to 2.75.
